YOUTH & THE CITY Partners Meet in Alicante to Evaluate Project Progress and Launch Youth Contest

Alicante, Spain 7-8 OCTOBER 2024

The YOUTH & THE CITY project, an innovative initiative focused on fostering municipalities to develop sustainable smart green citiesengaging with youth, held a productive partner meeting in Alicante, Spain. Hosted by AlJU, the meeting brought together representatives from six European partner organiations to evaluate key project outputs and plan upcoming youth engagement activities.

Key Achievements Review

The partners thoroughly evaluated three major project outputs:

- The consortium reviewed the collection of 24 innovative approaches to sustainable urban development from partner countries. This comprehensive booklet showcases successfulyouth-municipality collaborations in creating environmentally friendly urban solutions. Partners provided final feedback for optimization before public release.
- Partners assessed the structure and content of the training modules designed to empoweryoung people in smart city development. The framework, based on extensive research andyouth input, includes modules on environmental sustainability, digital tools, and youth-municipality cooperation.
- Digital Platform Progress: AlJU presented the development status of the Open Educational Resources (OER) platform - "YOUTH & THE CITY Digital Warehouse". Partners explored the platform's features and provided input on user experience and content accessibility in all project languages.

Youth Writing Contest Launch

- A significant portion of the meeting focused on planning the project's upcoming youth writing contest. Partners finalized:
- Contest themes focusing on environmental solutions for cities
- Participation criteria for young people aged 17-30
- Evaluation methodology
